

With ODOP, UP's exports went up by 28%: CM

Lucknow: The government's push to traditional craft and small industries through its one district-one product (ODOP) scheme led to a sharp increase in exports from UP, chief minister Yogi Adityanath has said.

Inaugurating 'Hunar Haat' at Awadh Shilp Gram on Saturday, the CM said that in 2018-19, UP's exports went up by 28% while all-India exports went up by just 8%.

"Moradabad district exported goods worth Rs 6,000 crore while Bhadohi district, famous for its carpets, exported goods worth Rs 4,000 crore. We will identify industries which have helped increase UP's exports and honour them," the CM said. Craftspersons will be honoured on January 24, when the state will celebrate its 70th foundation day.
